



Abstract guidelines

The **abstract** should be well focused on the Call Topic and should be written according to following indications.

The abstract must include the following information:

- Topic title and related focus
- Title
- Name of the author and eventually co-authors
- Affiliation
- E-mail address
- Maximum 6 keywords
- Summary of the proposal (**max 4000 characters including spaces**)

The abstract must be clear, following the track of the following points:

- Cultural and scientific background with regard to the proposed topic (insert in the text max 4 bibliographical references)
[1,500 characters, including spaces, bibliographical references included]
- Approach and / or methodology
[1,000 characters, spaces included]
- Analytical aspects, critical framework or debate related to the proposal
[500 characters, including spaces]
- Relevance of the theme regarding the topic
[500 characters, including spaces]
- Cultural, scientific or operational impacts
[500 characters, including spaces]

The author(s) must clearly declare the reference topic and focus; otherwise the abstract will not be accepted.

The **abstract** can be written in Italian or English and must be sent no later than **15th November 2019** through the **online submission** link.

Only one abstract per registered author is allowed (single author or in a group).

The Scientific Coordination will examine the proposals and will communicate their acceptance by **15th December 2019**.
